Since moving to Yorkshire in the summer, time has simply flown by. We barely seem to have finished unpacking ... and already it is Advent.


Advent is a time of expectation, a time of waiting, a time to reflect, and a time of hope.

Social/Fundraising Events

Another two Film Evenings have been enjoyed this season: £175 was raised at 'The Unlikely Pilgrimage of Harold Fry' in October and last month 'Save the Cinema' raised £105.

The Autumn Fayre was well supported and raised the grand total of £1,030 on the day - £430 on the Craft Stall (with more to come from sales of remaining items at local hairdressers up to Christmas!) and £600 on the rest of the stalls. A huge thank you to all who supported the event in any way.

The church stall at the Village Christmas Fair also did well, raising a further £50.

A £686 grant has been received from the Pebbles Fund of the Rank Foundation towards the cost of the new dishwasher last summer.

This has released other funds to enable the replacement of our commercial oven which stopped working last month. The new refurbished oven arrived just in time to cook Lunch Club Christmas Lunch!

28 light blue church chairs have been received from the now closed Cowling Methodist Church. These will go in the lounge once the AV desk returns to its former home at the back of church.




