Our Film Evening on Friday attracted 78 people of all ages for 'The Greatest Showman' and raised the record sum of £375. Everyone enjoyed the film and the fish and chips in the interval! We have now eaten our way through over £2,550 worth of fish and chips at the 26 film evenings and we are indebted to Oxford Fisheries for making up large orders very quickly!!

We are delighted to report that the total secured for the Appeal has now reached £377,157. The decision has been taken to appoint contractors as soon as the tenders have been received and value-engineered at the end of the month and we have confirmed that the project can be completed within our £425,000 budget.

Worship will take place in the Lounge from 3rd June as preparations begin for the building work, which is now scheduled to commence in July, for completion in October. The whole project should be finished by the end of November. Hall, Lounge, Kitchen & Toilets will be in use as normal whilst the work progresses.
